



Intuition and spontaneity are key to Bräuer's process. Instead of using plans or preliminary sketches, he rather let his immediate tactile experience of the clay guide the process. There is no preconceived idea of what a particular piece must look like and the highly immersive process of folding, wedging, moulding, and shaping clay gives direct shape to the final form. In this way, intuition pilots the process.
